We have to thank the Municipality of Riccione who sponsored the event and supported us in our initiative.



The CAP consists of the ESF Technical Director (Martin Wren), the Championship Director (Davide Babini) and the Championship Referee (Patrizio Potenza).

The ESF TD may recruit other members as appropriate.

The Adjudicating Committee shall be responsible for all final decisions on appeals during the Championships.

Please note the Hotel Poker and the Hotel Club are within 50m of each other.

CHECK-IN - ACCOMODATION

All participants, officials, etc. who have taken the "**Standard Package**", will come first to the official tournament Hotel Poker, where is located a Championship desk, from 12.00 to 18.30 on Tuesday — other check-in by arrangement. You will receive your room keys at the hotel reception. There will be no hotel check-in at the venue.

For those who have taken the "**Basic Package**", they will come to the Championship Office, located at the 1st floor of the venue, from 17.00 to 19.00

Every participant, coach, manager, official, supporter will be supplied with a badge. You will be required to wear this badge visibly throughout the championship. If you lose your badge, you must report this to the Championship Office immediately.

All players must settle the bill for all their extras to hotel reception before departure.

TOURNAMENT OFFICE

The Tournament Office will be located on the first floor in the Figs National Technical Centre. There you can get information about accommodation, meals, time schedule, practice courts, results etc...

Team's latest information and updates will be displayed on the information board.

Mail boxes for each team are situated in the Championships Office. For smooth running of the Championships, we ask Team Managers to visit the Office to collect their team's information sheets and daily results in order to empty their boxes regularly.

The European Club Championships will have Live Scoring on gallery court and court N°1.

MEALS – FINAL DINNER

For all those who have booked the Standard Package all the meals (breakfast – lunch – dinner) will be served in the hotels (Club & Poker) at these times:

Breakfast will be served from 07:00 am to 10:00 am
Lunch will be served from 12:00 pm to 15:00 pm
Dinner will be served from 19:30 pm to 22:30 pm

The final dinner will be at "**Hotel Club**". You need your accreditation card to eat at the hotel and all other services. Don't lose it!

TRANSPORTATION

There will be an operated shuttle service between the official hotels and the venue. Please see the shuttle schedule attached as Annex 3.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

All who book the standard package and who have made arrangements will be picked up at Rimini airport or Rimini/ Riccione railway station - or by other arrangement.

OPENING

There will be just a short opening speech at the Figs National Technical Centre at 19.00 before the Managers Meeting

MANAGERS MEETING

The Managers Meeting for the Championship will be held at the Figs National Technical Centre on Tuesday 17th September 2013 at 20.00

REFEREES MEETING

The Referees Meeting for the Championship will be held at the Figs National Technical Centre on Wednesday 18th September 2013 at 08.15

REFEREES/ MARKERS

FIGS have provided qualified referees and markers but all teams are reminded that, if requested, they are obliged to provide referees/markers.

SQUASH BALL

The Dunlop PRO XX ball (double yellow dot) will be used for all matches.

TIN HEIGHT

All men's semi-final, 3/4 play off and finals matches will be played on courts with a 17" tin height. All other matches will be played with a 19" tin height.

TEAM NOMINATION – PLAYERS ON COURT

The squad playing order shall be adhered to throughout the Championships. Any player can be omitted from a Tie provided the others play in the order of merit approved by the CAP.

Unless the Championships Director is notified otherwise in writing at least one hour before the scheduled start of a Tie or within 10 minutes of completion of the previous Tie (whichever is the later), Managers shall be deemed to have selected their top players. The CAP reserves the right to allow changes to player nominations after the deadline for each Tie in exceptional circumstances.

Daily team nominations must be handed in the tournament office at Figs National Technical Centre or by email at ecc2013@federsquash.it at least ONE hour before the tie is scheduled, otherwise the top players shall be deemed to have been selected.

It is the responsibility of each team to be ready at the advertised start time of the tie. Every nominated player must be present at the venue at the start time of the tie or be withdrawn from the team.

PLAYING ORDER

The playing order of matches in all Ties on each day of the Championships will be drawn by the CAP and shall be posted in the Tournament Office and in Hotel Poker.

PRACTICE COURTS

On Tuesday 17th september practice courts are available from 10.00 to 19.00. Each session is 30 minutes. For reservations please contact ecc2013@federsquash.it

On all other days the team managers book their practice times through the tournament office at Figs National Technical Centre (see annex 2).

MEDICAL

Medical staff will be on duty during pre-booked practice and match times at the venue. Players who require medical attention outside match times should liaise with the tournament office.

PHISIO

A phisio will be available during match times at the venue. Phisio sessions can be booked through the tournament office (each session is 40 minutes and costs 30 € - paid in cash at the office).

ANTIDOPING

The ESF and Host Association reserve the right to implement compulsory dope testing for any player participating in the Championships. A notice to this effect shall be included on the Entry Form. The doping regulations shall be those published by the WSF.

Dope testing might be carried out during the European Club Championships under the regulations of the Italian Olympic Committee (CONI).

EYE PROTECTION – JUNIOR PLAYERS

All Junior players (U19) participating in the Championships must wear approved eye protection throughout practice and play.

CHANGING ROOMS

The changing rooms are located on the ground floor of the Centre.. All the teams (men's and women's) will be allocated their own locker for the duration of the event.

The Figs National Technical Centre is located within a major Sport Complex which comprises tennis courts, beach tennis courts, Olympic swimming pool and more.

SQUASH BAGS

All squash bags should be kept under your own supervision at all times. No responsibility can be accepted for loss or damage to personal items. Please do not leave any belongings in the changing rooms. Bags that are left in awkward or safety restricted places will be removed.

RACKET STRINGING

Racket stringing service is available through **MIX SPORT** Shop, who is located at 200m from the venue (see the map for more information). Racket stringing normally takes 24 hours but a quicker service may be available if requested. Please pay stringing costs in advance.

TEAM PHOTOGRAPHS

Team photographs will be taken at the venue, each day, from 10:00 hrs till 18:00 hrs upon request. All teams are asked to arrange a fixed time with the tournament office. We will take digital photos that could be downloaded from the official event website.

WI-FI

Both the hotels are equipped and have Wifi connection facilities. At the venue the Wi-fi connection is available on request only to team managers.

VICTORY CEREMONY

The prize-giving ceremony will follow immediately after the men's final. The top 3 teams — men and women must be present in team track-suits at the gallery court.


Annex #1 – Map
